**Tab Systems garners IFSEC nomination**

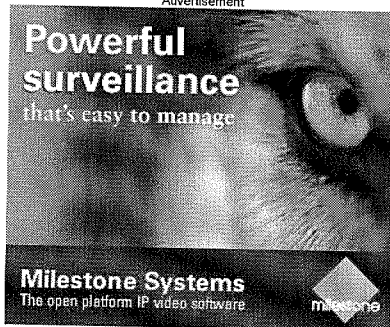

NAKLO, Slovenia—Tab Systems, a developer and manufacturer of multi-modal biometric systems for identification, access control, time and attendance and building automation, has been selected as an IFSEC awards finalist for its newest smarti access control unit, the smarti Diadem.

The nomination marks the third successive year smarti has been singled out for recognition at IFSEC.

The unit, which has been shortlisted by the British Security Industry Association (BSIA) this year as one of the six best new access control products, identifies people by who they are—face and voice recognition—rather than by what ID card or key they carry.

The system works by saving the biometric information of an individual in a quick enrollment process. The smarti unit then uses this information to recognize a person and then acts based on pre-defined instructions that the system controller sets up. This could include saving a photo of the person in the event log and then opening a door, turning on a light, sending an e-mail or sms, or a combination of actions.

The smarti Diadem also includes additional integrated features, such as video intercom, video and IP phone and video messaging and surveillance.
